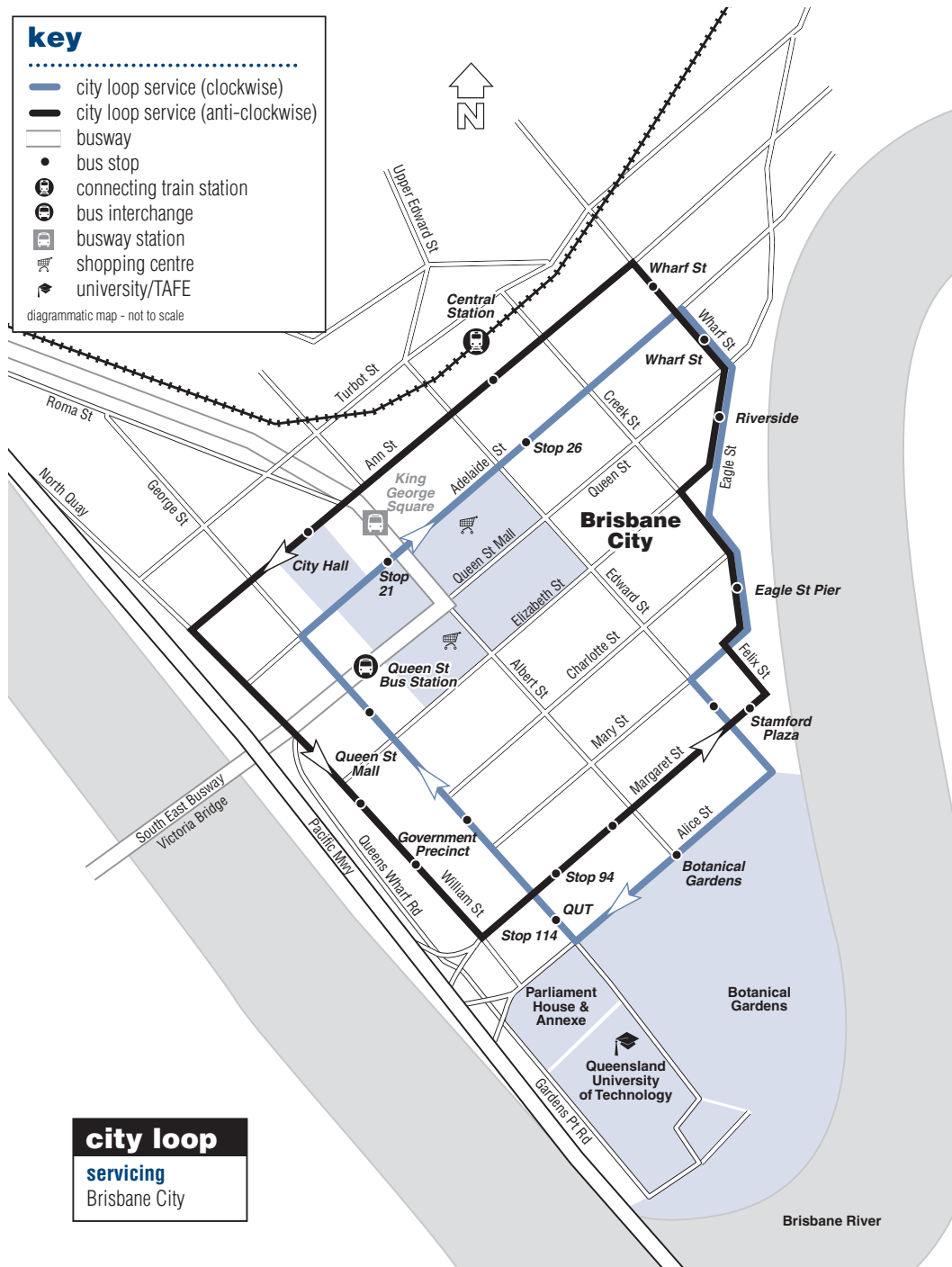

The loop is a service operating in both directions around the City Centre.

It is a convenient way to travel between locations in the city and provides good connections between Central Railway Station and the southern section of the City.

Travel on the loop is free.

The bus stops on this service have distinctive red signposts.

- accessibility

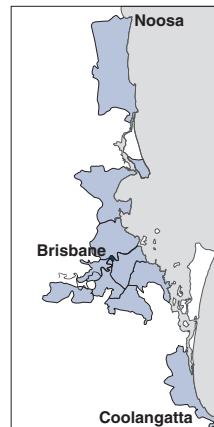
The TransLink call centre operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
